The Castlerock Road diversion works are progressing well against the project schedule.

Sections of the existing Dorset Road have seen the final pavement layers placed as well as seal, linemarking, and guard rail installed.

The upgrade of the eastern end of Dorset Road will continue over the coming months. Works will progress to connect the existing Castlerock Road to the new road. Traffic will continue to be maintained along Castlerock Road via temporary arrangements.

- Drainage structures and roadworks.
- Permanent pavement construction on Dorset Road and the new road.
- Guardrail, sealing and line marking
- Roadworks and safety improvements on the western portion of Castlerock Road.
- Roadworks at the tie-in location on Castlerock Road
